Preliminary Sketches Can Produce a Successful Finished Painting.

Original Reference Imagery

By the time I start to apply paint to my paper or canvas, I want to be friends with the subject matter. I know from experience that it will ultimately contribute to a more successful finished painting. In addition, I'll sometimes make notes that might pertain to light source or value placement or image editing (for example).

Our photo or subject matter should serve primarily as inspiration. Very seldom will we choose to include every detail that is otherwise contained in the original image. You'll notice I changed the face of the open doorway to a lighter value. This contributed to making this a focal point as you will see when comparing the photo to the color sketch. By putting our darkest dark next to our lightest light, we also create more interest. This is one of the goals to achieving an exciting and successful painting.

Often I'll create a color sketch as well. Neither the B&W or color sketch should display a lot of detail.
