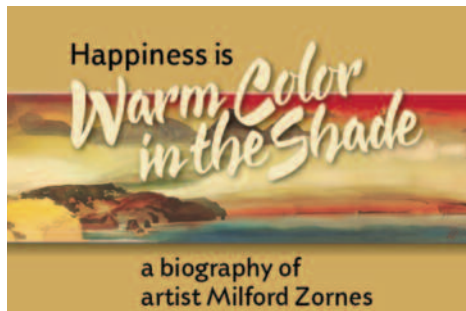

Exclusive Zornes' Exhibit, as Part of California Gold, Continues at The Art Place Thru March 15th

The exhibition will consist of several pieces of Milford Zornes' artwork. Zornes' most-viewed work is almost certainly the 1937 mural inside the Claremont Post Office, which wraps around all four walls. Across 60 feet, it depicts scenes of Claremont life: farmers, citrus, the college and Mexican dancers. Lore has it that the images correspond to the points on a compass, although Baker said he's unaware of any truth to that.

PVAA will also be hosting a group exhibition titled "California Gold celebrating an influential founder, MILFORD ZORNES", through March 15th at The PVAA Art Place.

By-laws
March 2018 Amendments

- ARTICLE I: The name of the organization shall be: Pomona Valley Art Association. For purposes of legal reference the organization may be referred to as Pomona Valley Art Association, Inc. The abbreviation PVAA may also be used to represent the organization for reference and publications and hereinafter.
- ARTICLE II: Purpose: To benefit the public through the stimulation of creative interest, education and enjoyment of art in all its various forms. The PVAA shall provide venue(s) and exhibition opportunities to PVAA members.
- ARTICLE III: Membership Eligibility: Artists or art enthusiasts in good standing. Membership in the PVAA shall be a privilege revokable by Board action should a members actions be determined by the PVAA Board to be detrimental to the association. Revocation of membership shall be without refund or compensation.
- All members shall be entitled to privileges accorded herein and subject to responsibilities of PVAA membership.
- Membership Levels and Dues shall be as established by the Board of Directors and specified per policies and procedures.
- ARTICLE IV: Board of Directors
- Section 1: Directors
- a. Officers shall be: President, Vice President, Treasurer, Membership Chairman, Recording Secretary, Board Member(s) At large.
 - b. The Board of Directors shall transact all business and have general supervision of the affairs of the PVAA.
 - c. A Board Year shall run from the July 1st until June 30th of the following year.
 - d. PVAA Board of Directors for the following Board Year shall be nominated in January by a Nominating Committee. At the June general meeting the Board of Directors for the following year shall be elected and installed. The term for the elected Board shall begin upon installation.
 - e. Should any Board Member be absent from three (3) consecutive Board meetings without due cause, he/she may lose their place on the Board.

- f. In the case of a vacant position during the year, the President shall appoint new Board members subject to Board approval.
- g. Board member may be added during the year by a 2/3 majority vote of the Board.
- h. The Board may establish Policies and Procedures to regulate and administer PVAA operations. Policies and Procedures enacted by the board shall constitute direction by the board.

Section 2: Duties

- a. **PRESIDENT** shall preside at all meetings of the PVAA and the Board, appoint all special committees including an auditor. The president shall call special meetings, make an annual report, act as ex-officio member of all committee meetings except Nominating Committee. The president shall have general supervision over all plans for extending, unifying, and rendering efficient the work of the PVAA; may sign checks in lieu of the Treasurer, sign contracts and documents for the PVAA and perform such other duties as pertain to the office. The President (and other board members appointed by the president) shall have check signing privileges and sign all checks for payment of the bills of the PVAA.
- b.
- c. **VICE PRESIDENT** shall assist the President, and in the absence of the President, shall discharge the duties of the President. In case of resignation or death of the President, shall become President for the unexpired term.
- d. **TREASURER** shall be the custodian of all funds of the PVAA unless otherwise provided; keep an itemized account of all receipts and expenditures and make a monthly report to the Board of Directors. The Treasurer shall deposit the funds of the PVAA in a bank of the Board's choosing.
- e.
- f. **MEMBERSHIP CHAIRPERSON** processes applications and renewals, keeps a database of current members and an updated mailing list that is forwarded each month to the Board of Directors.
- g. **RECORDING SECRETARY** shall keep an accurate record of all the proceedings of the PVAA and Board meetings and keep current changes in the by-laws following Board action on file.

- h. **BOARD MEMBER(S) AT LARGE** shall attend meetings and carry out other duties as assigned or volunteered.

ARTICLE V: Appointed Committees

Section 1: Nominating Committee. The President shall appoint a committee of three (3) PVAA members in November of the prior Board Year. They shall solicit nominations for the Directors from the membership for the coming Board Year and present the names of the nominees at the January Board meeting and post the nominees in the March Newsletter.

Section 2: Other Committees: The President shall appoint other committees as shall meet the needs of the PVAA, and or as specified and directed by the Board.

ARTICLE VI: Meetings

Section 1: Board of Directors meetings shall consist of one meeting each month unless waived by the board. The date, hour and place of all Board of Directors meetings shall be decided by the Board.

Section 2: A general meeting shall be held on the third Saturday of June (unless changed by Board action) where the slate of officers proposed by the nominating committee is presented to the general membership and voted upon by PVAA membership. Date of the June Board meeting shall be announced in the March Newsletter.

Section 3: The Board of Directors for the coming year shall be elected and installed at the general meeting in June and published in the July newsletter.

Section 4: Special meetings may be called by the President or by an officer of the Board.

Section 5: A quorum of the Board shall be six (6) members of the Board.

ARTICLE VII: Exhibitions

Section 1: Annual Art Shows shall be held in locations designated by the Board.

Section 2: There shall be at least two (2) Annual Art Shows each year including but not limited to The Open Juried Show and the Young Artist Show.

ARTICLE VIII Pomona Valley Art Association Newsletter

The PVAA shall publish a newsletter following regular Board meetings as directed by the Board.

ARTICLE IX: Amendments

These by-laws may be amended by the Association at any Board meeting upon notice having been given by publication in the previous Newsletter of the proposed amendment.

ARTICLE X: Rules of Order

Roberts Rules of Order shall guide PVAA meetings to provide an orderly assembly and shall not be used to circumvent or nullify board majority action. PVAA meetings shall, with all reasonable effort, operate under the premiss of:

- Justice and equality to all.
- Courtesy to all.
- Address one issue at a time.
- The will of the majority.
- The right of the minority to be heard.
- Partiality to none.
